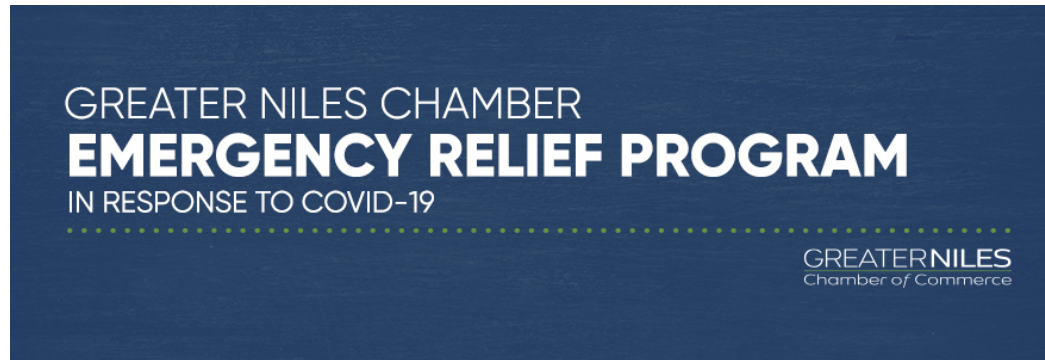

Greater Niles Chamber Emergency Relief Program

The Greater Niles Chamber of Commerce has introduced the Greater Niles Chamber Emergency Relief Program (ERP) in light of recent developments concerning the COVID-19, coronavirus public health crisis. The ERP is designed to support the greater Niles businesses that are affected by COVID-19 and the subsequent mitigation efforts within the region.

The Greater Niles Chamber Emergency Relief Program is for locally owned, small business members (less than 100 employees) located within the Greater Niles Chamber of Commerce's designated service areas of the City of Niles, Niles Township, the City of Buchanan, Buchanan Township, Bertrand Township, and Howard Township that are being impacted by recent closure mandates.

The relief program is designed for entities directly affected by Governor Gretchen Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-9 and Executive Order 2020-20. The Chamber will be distributing up to \$100,000 to member businesses to aid in the relief efforts. Applicants will be able to request up to \$10,000.

Applications are due Friday, April 17.
