## Michigan Enters Phase 4 of MI Safe Start Plan

On Monday, June 1, Governor Gretchen Whitmer signed [Executive Order 2020-110](#), rescinding her Safer at Home order and moving the state of Michigan into phase four of the [MI Safe Start Plan](#).

Included in this executive order, retailers will be able to resume normal operations on Thursday, June 4 at 12:01 a.m., or as subject to local regulation and to the capacity constraints outlined in [Executive Order 2020-97](#).

Additionally, restaurants, food courts, cafes, bars, etc. will be allowed to reopen both indoor and outdoor seating on Monday, June 8 at 12:01 a.m., or as subject to local regulation and to the capacity constraints outlined in [Executive Order 2020-97](#).

Also described in [Executive Order 2020-110](#):

- Outdoor social gatherings and events are permitted so long as the gathering does not exceed 100 people and attendees that are not part of the same household maintain social distancing.
- Indoor gatherings and events are permitted so long as the gathering does not exceed 10 people.
- Businesses that are capable to continue remote work are required to continue doing so.
- Individuals who leave their residence or place of work at any time are still required to practice social distancing and wear a face covering over his or her nose and mouth when in an enclosed public space.

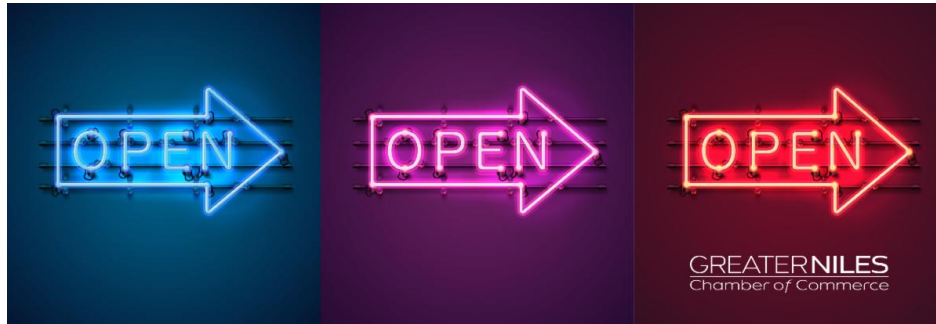
